- No fishing from the west shore, boat docks, bridges, Gazebo, or immediately below the Gazebo.
- Bank fishing is permitted from the south, east, north shores, and east of the boat launch ramp.
- No purchasing or trading fish.
- All vehicles must be parked in the parking lot.
- Each person fishing is limited to two poles.
- Persons possessing fish over the daily limit may be charged with a minor misdemeanor.
- Cleaning of fish on park property is prohibited.
- Throw nets and lines are prohibited.
- Use of live fish as bait is prohibited.
- No alcoholic beverages may be brought into the park.
