

1.3 Special Event Parking Fee

Effective Date: January 1, 2023

A Special Event Parking Fee will be collected for non-MetroParks events defined as: a sport, recreational, business or other type of activity that uses MetroParks property or has impact on the public realm and is not sponsored or co-sponsored by MetroParks. Parking fees will be set annually.

Definition of Special Event

Any organized, pre-planned event that is projected to cause a gathering of 50 or more people on MetroParks owned or managed property, but outside of the confines of a MetroParks reservable facility agreement and/or which features any of the following shall be considered a Special Event:

- amplified sound
- sales of concessions
- merchandise
- tickets and/or services
- the solicitation of donations
- events open and/or advertised to the public
- setup of stages, tents, tables, barricades or other items
- contractual agreement between an Organizer and MetroParks.
