

FALL FOLIAGE HIKES

Rentschler Forest MetroPark, Cascades Trail

The 0.8-mile Cascades Trail loop is the destination for leaf peepers at Rentschler Forest MetroPark. The trail meanders along Kennedy Creek and up a moderate hill to the top of the park. Take in the sights and sounds of the season on this colorful, shaded trail.

Gireat Miami River Trail

The northern (Middletown) section of the Great Miami River

to the Great Miami River and admire the changing leaves with a
leisurely stroll or bike ride.
