## ABOUT

The Adopt-A-Trail Program invites local organizations, community groups, and small businesses to partner with MetroParks of Butler County to support the stewardship and beautification of our trail system. By adopting a trail, participants make a meaningful contribution to the health and enjoyment of our parks while strengthening their visibility within the community.

## WHY ADOPT A TRAIL?

The Adopt-A-Trail Program is an excellent way to give back, build team spirit, express community leadership, and show your support for preserving the natural spaces that make Butler County and the MetroParks special.

## HOW IT WORKS

For a small annual fee, each trail adopter receives:

- Personalized recognition through branded on-trail signage
- A listing on the MetroParks website
- Two window clings to display at their business, meeting space, or company vehicles
- One annual complimentary shelter reservation (based on availability)

In return, each group commits to completing two service opportunities on their trail per year, helping us maintain safe, clean, and welcoming trails for all visitors.

## ADOPTION TERM & COST

Trail adoptions are for a three-year period, ensuring continuity and investment in the space. Cost is based on annual park visitation numbers and are listed below along with all available trails.
