Rules and Regulations

Bank fishing is permitted from the south, east, north shores, and east of the boat launch ramp.

No fishing from the west shore, boat docks, bridges, Gazebo, or immediately below the Gazebo.

No purchasing or trading fish.

All vehicles must be parked in the parking lot.

Each person fishing is limited to two poles.

Persons possessing fish over the daily limit may be charged with a minor misdemeanor.

Cleaning of fish on VOA MetroPark property is prohibited.

Throw nets and lines are prohibited.

Use of live fish as bait is prohibited.

No alcoholic beverages may be brought into the park.
