

MetroParks began as the Butler County Park Board in 1955. when a group of concerned citizens came together with the common purpose to preserve and restore natural areas in **Butler County. Today, park** users experience educational and recreational programs and activities happening countywide with MetroParks.

PARK EXPERIENCES

These programs are conducted for a variety of audiences including: schools, organizations, private groups, homeschool groups, birthday parties, scout groups, and more. All program instruction can be adapted to meet the needs of specific groups.

As part of a program customization, MetroParks staff could modify the activities, topic, or time frame within reason. Scout programs are prepared to fulfill specific badge or activity requirements. School programs are prepared to satisfy age/grade specific Ohio Learning Standards.

WANT US TO COME TO YOU?

MetroParks offers some of our field trips in the classroom! The three starred field trips above (Amazing Animals, Fossil Expedition, and Calling All Farmhands) are able to be adapted for outside the parks.

GRADES: Each off-site program can cover the same grades and learning standards as their field trip version.

FEES: The first program at a location each day is \$150, with each additional program being \$50.

DURATION: 45 minutes

BIRTHDAY PARTIES



Celebrate your birthday with MetroParks! Each birthday party includes a one hour naturalist-guided program, and an outdoor shelter rental.

COST:

\$150 for a 1 hour guided program and shelter rental for up to 20 children. Each child in attendance over the 20 child limit will be charged an additional fee of \$6 per child.

FOOD, BEVERAGE & DECORATIONS:

Birthday party organizers are welcome to bring their own food to serve, but MetroParks will not provide any utensils of any kind. Alcohol is strictly prohibited. Decorations are permitted, but must follow MetroParks' facility rules and regulations.





READY TO SCHEDULE?

To schedule a program with MetroParks, email <u>programs@yourmetroparks.net</u>, or call 513-867-5835. All programs must be scheduled at least 30 days in advance.

Once you receive the finalized program proposal it must be completed, and a deposit paid within 14 calendar days.

PAYMENT


Cost is listed with each program description. A non-refundable \$50 deposit is required for each day scheduled to finalize your planned program(s) and will be applied your total program cost.

The remaining balance will be invoiced after your program. Payment can be processed online, over the phone via card, or by mailed in check. Payments cannot be accepted at or before your program.



CANCELLATION AND REFUNDS

Deposit is not refunded if the customer cancels the program. If MetroParks cancels the program due to inclement weather or some other unforeseen circumstance, the deposit is refunded in full.
