MetroParks of Butler County has a bench donation program designed to help park visitors, nonprofits, or businesses remember a friend or loved one, recognize an important event or accomplishment, or simply support the Mission of the MetroParks. The bench donation program funds the addition of much needed benches on walking paths, trails, shelters, waterways and playgrounds, while leaving a lasting legacy in your favorite park. In order to provide a consistent and well-maintained look, MetroParks has selected two bench types that will be used in selected MetroParks locations across Butler County. The bench styles and associated costs are shown below. As part of the program, MetroParks will send all donors a letter acknowledging the gift and, if requested, will send a notice regarding the donation to another person (a friend, a family member or other person) designated by the donor/sponsor.
