CHRONOLOG INSTALLATION AT LINE HILL MOUND AREA

Now's your chance to help us record the ever-changing landscapes within our park! The Line Hill Meadow Restoration Project consists of an 8.5-acre old field overrun with non-native invasive plants like Autumn Olive, Bush Honeysuckle, and Callery Pear. The invasive plants have been removed and the site will be seeded with native prairie and grassland species. Help document the changes as this overgrown field is restored to a native meadow using our new Chronolog stand!

Changes in our environment are difficult to see and understand because they happen gradually, but long-term monitoring projects are expensive and complex. Chronolog solves this problem by connecting communities with land stewards to create crowd-sourced time lapses of important natural areas.



To take part in this citizen science project all you need to do is visit the Chronolog station at Line Hill and follow the instructions on the attached signed. To see the prarie progress visit Chronolog.io/map
