Parental Consent Form

Additionally, the MetroParks staff will take every reasonable precaution to ensure the safety of youth participating in the Volunteer Program and to carefully explain each assigned task. Youth volunteers will not be asked to, or permitted to, operate equipment or take part in any activities which, if they were employees, that Ohio Minor Labor Laws prevent their participation.
